
## Academic Growth



## Student Attendance and Mobility


### Attendance Rate

## School Highlights

### Academic Courses

Chelsea Intermediate School's goal is to foster the academic and social emotional development of our students using a variety of instructional approaches and programs that include differentiated instruction, integrated units created through the Backwards Design model, Sensory Integration, and Character Counts.

### Physical Education, Health and Wellness

Our physical education program includes an emphasis on fitness and assisting students with making healthy choices. In addition to providing exposure to many major sports and activities, the also curriculum includes instruction on nutrition and diet to ensure students are able to apply this information to their dietary selections on a daily basis.

### Other Programs and Activities

Chelsea Intermediate School partners with our local police department to provide multiple safety assemblies to our students, including an Internet Safety Assembly, Halloween Safety Assembly, and the DARE Program which is provided to our fifth graders for nine weeks each year.

### School Awards

Chelsea Intermediate School earned the Excellence Award for Exemplary Academic Performance in 2010 and 2011 from the State of Illinois. Chicago Magazine listed Chelsea Intermediate School as one of their A+ Top Ten Best Schools in Will County.

### Career Development Courses and Programs

Our students are provided with a variety of activities throughout the year to support Career Development. These activities are imbedded in the core curriculum and supported through our Encore classes, which include weekly activities in library, technology, art and music.

Chelsea Intermediate School staff includes three social workers, three speech pathologists, four reading or math interventionists, one school nurse, one school psychologist, and additional staff dedicated to meeting the needs of our students with IEP services, ESL services and gifted programming.

### Facilities



## District Finance
