

SCHOOL HEALTH REQUIREMENTS FOR STATE COMPLIANCE 2019-2020

Pre-K

- Physical Exam with immunizations
- Children aged 24-59 months shall show proof of immunizations that complies with the **Pneumococcal vaccination schedule.**

K

- Physical Exam with immunizations
- Dental Exam
- Vision Exam

2nd

- Dental Exam

6th

- Physical Exam with immunizations
 - Tdap 1 dose
 - Meningococcal Conjugate vaccine on or after 11th birthday
- Dental Exam

NEW STUDENTS TO AN

ILLINOIS SCHOOL

- Physical Exam with immunizations on an **Illinois school form**
- Vision Exam
- Must be done within 30 days of entering our district

FSD 157-C requires school health exams be turned into the school **no later than October 15th for students in preschool, kindergarten & 6th grade.** New students who register after October 15th of the current school year shall have 30 days following registration to comply with the health examination and immunization regulations.

PARENTS/GUARDIANS – YOU MUST COMPLETE & SIGN THE HEALTH HISTORY SECTION ON THE BACK OF YOUR CHILD’S PHYSICAL FORM BEFORE TURNING IT INTO THE SCHOOL. As your Health Care Providers complete the forms, make a copy for your records, and send the original to your child’s school health office. Forms are accepted at all school offices all year long.
